Approach to Employment

IPS (Individual Placement Services)

Evidence-based approach to working with individuals living with mental illness in securing employment

Principles are applicable to all persons with disabilities

- Competitive Employment is the Goal
- Zero Exclusion
- Job Seeker Preferences Honored
- Integration of Vocational and Mental Health Treatment services
- Benefits Counseling
- Rapid Job Search
- Employment Specialists Build Relationships with Community Employers
- Job Retention Supports are Time Unlimited



Employment First

- The goal of employment services is to assist job seekers in securing integrated community employment.
- Employment counselors assist job seekers with all activities associated with obtaining employment:
 - > Resume development
 - > Interview prep
 - > Application completion
 - > Job search
 - > Job Development
 - Job Coaching
 - Career path development based on interest level and skills



Department of Rehabilitation Services (DRS):

- We have a contract with DRS to provide community services (Primary Funder)
- All clients in our program are than opened to a DRS counselor to remain in compliance
- Upon being opened to DRS there are consistent meetings to ensure contractual bench marks are being met for both the client and DRS



Referral Process

- Q will submit a referral (for job placement or job retention) form to Tom Coker
- ES is assigned and will begin working with the client
- ES will keep in contact with the client's Q and set up an initial meeting prior to meeting the client
- ES makes referral to DRS

- Staff Food Handling Course upon hire to all DSP's (August 2023), hands on cooking for DSP's (September 2023)




